The Union County Summer Arts Festival 2010 concert series begins a new season of music on Wednesday evening, June 30, with a performance by "Tramps Like Us" – one of the most recognized Bruce Springsteen tribute bands. The free concert begins at 7:30 p.m. in Echo Lake Park in Mountainside.

Tramps Like Us is a group of seasoned, professional musicians with a repertoire of more than 100 tunes from the Bruce Springsteen songbook. Formed in 1990, Tramps Like Us doesn't just sound like the Boss – they are the next best thing to the Boss himself. They capture the classic Springsteen sound and remain true to the spirit and energy of the music. Tramps Like
