Dog Parade

- All participants must be registered to participate either by stopping by Parks & Recreation or signing up the day of (2:00 check-in required at the skate park). Fee is \$10.00; all proceeds will go towards the Rocky Hill Dog Park.
- Dogs must be licensed and have rabies tag
- Dogs must be people and dog friendly to participate.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Owners are responsible for curbing their dogs.
- Costume contest with prizes for best dressed up dogs.
